CHEWING GUM I have had a couple of complaints of gum on clothing. People leaving it under benches etc. Can I remind you that there is still an hours fasting law before Communion so people should not be chewing gum in church.

#### SWINE FLU (Taking Precautions)

A Pandemic is being seriously discussed by Doctors and World Leaders. The Archbishop has sent some recommendations to all parishes. The first is that we will not use a physical sign of peace; perspiration on the hands can pass on the flu. The Holy Water Font has been emptied for the same reason. He also highly recommends that we receive Holy Communion in the hand as Communion received on the tongue could put both the communicant and other communicants at risk. Receiving from the Chalice; given the alcohol in the consecrated wine presents no great risk, but the choice to receive from the Chalice rests with each communicant. I ask that the Eucharistic Ministers make sure that the Chalices are not only purified but washed with soap and water after each mass.
