SWINE FLU (Taking Precautions)

A Pandemic is being seriously discussed by Doctors and World Leaders. The Archbishop has sent some recommendations to all parishes. The first is that we will not use a physical sign of peace; perspiration on the hands can pass on the flu. The Holy Water Font has been emptied for the same reason. He also highly recommends that we receive Holy Communion in the hand as Communion received on the tongue could put both the communicant and other communicants at risk. Receiving from the Chalice is now also deemed a risk; so until further notice we will only receive Communion under one kind.
