'Leaving Safe Harbours' was launched by Archbishop Kelly in 2007 and Pastoral Areas throughout the Archdiocese have been responding to it. The priests, sisters and deacons of our Pastoral Area, (Liverpool South), have met each month to discuss how we will prepare for the future when there will be only 4 or 5 priests in the area (This will include the Benedictines in St Austin's and the Franciscans in St Anthony's). In addition to the monthly meetings they have held two study days to discuss the issues in more depth.

The challenges that face us involve the use of buildings, the deployment of clergy and the increasing involvement of laity as well as the best way of providing for the pastoral needs of parishioners.

We are now looking at involving more people in planning for the future and will be seeking your ideas as we move forward.

Our Pastoral Area, Liverpool South, stretches from the city centre to Garston and consists of the following 12 parishes, comprising 14 churches:

Holy Trinity and St Francis of Assisi, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, St Anne & St Bernard, St Anthony of Padua, St Austin, St Bemadette, St Charles Borromeo, St Clare, St Hugh of Lincoln, St Patrick, St Thomas More, St Vincent de Paul

Currently there are 11 priests and 5 deacons.
